This matter came on for hearing on December 3, 2021 upon motion from Class Counsel asking that certain administrative matters be addressed. Now therefore the Court addresses those matters as well as other pending matters and does hereby find, orders and adjudge as follows:

1. Numerical paragraph 10 of the Court's Order entered herein on November 22, 2021, is restated in its entirety and to read as follows:


10. On or before December 15, 2021, Angeion shall make an initial distribution to those 1,795 individuals or entities that have been confirmed and thoroughly vetted as Class Members. Such initial distribution shall be determined by each member's pro rata share of a potential class comprised of 3,253 members.

2. The Court previously ordered and required that Class Counsel submit an itemized statement for those appointed attorneys and paralegal time incurred from their appointment through November 12, 2021. Having reviewed the itemized statement of Class Counsel attorney

and paralegal time submitted *in camera* totaling \$458,282.00 and finding that such time is reasonable and was performed for the benefit of the Settlement Class, the Court hereby orders that the BTGCA shall forthwith disburse said \$458,282.00 to McBrayer PLLC.

3. Counsel for the parties being in agreement, ¶¶ 9 and 11 of the Order are amended to allow BTGCA to forward to the Settlement Administrator only those funds needed to make the ordered partial distribution to 1795 class members, to retain remaining funds in the ICS account it has established for the partial settlement, and to make disbursements relating to the partial settlement from those funds. The Court allows and encourages the parties and dissolution committee to work out the details and logistics of settlement administration between themselves.
