Settlement Class Counsel's Status Report

Settlement Class Counsel, Katherine K. Yunker and Jason R. Hollon, hereby provide the following status report detailing recent actions taken in the administration of the Settlement. Class Counsel state as follows:

1. On May 18, 2022, the Settlement Administrator mailed 147 checks in an amount of \$5,670.00 each as part of an initial distribution to a third group of eligible Class members. Some of those being sent the third initial distribution owed outstanding Tobacco Administrative Grading Service ("TAGS") fees which were subtracted from the amount sent to each such person.

2. A small number of persons (individuals and business entities) remain under consideration for eligibility to share in the net Co-op dissolution proceeds as a member of the Settlement Class. Initial distribution to anyone not already issued a check will either be made individually, in small batches, or may be sent with an intermediate distribution made to all eligible Class members.

3. In accordance with prior Orders, McBrayer PLLC was paid an attorney's fee proportional to the third initial distribution described herein.

4. Settlement Class Counsel are scheduling hearing times for those who have submitted a timely written objection, on the days designated by the Court (June 14 and 15, 2022, and July 18 and 20, 2022).
